

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Dear Whidbey Telephone Company Customer,

Whidbey Telephone Company ("Whidbey Telecom") has filed for approval from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission" or "WUTC") to increase its revenue by \$8,444.00 annually which is approximately 2.62 percent of the revenue for residential customers. If approved, the increase will take effect December 1, 2021. The rate increases are set forth in the table below.

Please note that if the proposed rates are approved, the Access Recovery Charge or ARC of \$3.00 per month will go away. This means the net effect on your bill is an increase of \$1.55 per month. Also, please note that this proposal does not apply to customers subscribing to our non-tariff digital voice service that is provided in conjunction with our broadband service.

WUTC last approved new rates for Whidbey Telecom on May 1, 2016.

Overall costs to provide service, such as wages, taxes and other factors, have increased and, as always, regulatory compliance costs continue to rise.
