**IMPORTANT NOTICE OF RATES For 1-Inch METERED CUSTOMERS**

It is proposed that the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission update the water rates charged for one (1") customers by Kalama Water LLC. The proposed rates are taken from our 3/4 -inch meter rates and upsized based on commission meter size factors for larger meters. The new rates will be effective on December 1, 2021. The rates will be based on water used after December 1, and reflected on your December 31, 2021 billing.

Below is a table showing the water rates for 1-Inch meters.

<b>Monthly Rates</b>	<b>Rate</b>
Base Rate	\$75.00
Base rate includes an allowance of 12,460 gallons per month	NA
12,461 – 24,930 gallons per 1,000 gallons or portion thereof	\$3.00
Over 24,930 gallons per 1,000 gallons or portion thereof	\$5.00
