Re: Review Committee Decision – Case 21-039 Millennium Landscape & Construction, Inc vs. Puget Sound Energy

Dear Amanda Maxwell:

The Washington State Dig Law Safety Committee received a complaint regarding a potential violation of Washington State Dig Law RCW 19.122.030 for work performed on 08/06/2021.

On November 10, 2021, the committee formed a review board and heard Case 21-039 filed by Millennium Landscape & Construction, Inc. against Puget Sound Energy.

The review board determined that the respondent violated RCW 19.122.030(3)(a) on two occasions by failing to mark with reasonable accuracy on each occasion.

Therefore, the committee recommends a total penalty of \$10,000 being assessed to the respondent as follows:

- \$5,000 penalty for the first violations of RCW 19.122.030(3)(a)
- \$5,000 penalty for the second violation of RCW 19.122.030(3)(a)

The recommended penalties total \$10,000.
