Dear Director/Secretary Maxwell,

We are submitting this transmittal letter and an adjustment to Item 230 of Tariff Number 7 for San Juan Sanitation Inc., permit G-144. Enclosed please find revised tariff pages, and the notice from Skagit County Public Works. This is an adjustment with an Effective Date of June 1, 2022.

Skagit County Public Works has sent us a letter announcing their implementation of a rate increase effective June 1, 2022. We may take an occasional pass-through load to Skagit County Transfer Station, so we have updated our Item 230. Through an inter-local agreement, waste generated in San Juan County will be charged the municipal rate of \$103 per ton plus a \$7 per ton surcharge. The new rate will total \$110 per ton. No residential or commercial rates would increase.
