Enclosed are revised tariff pages 2, 22, 23, 24, 25, and 26. The primary purpose of the revisions to these tariff pages is to align default container sizes with that of Chapter 9.48 of the Kitsap County Code. This revision also includes the addition of the compostable organics program description for multifamily customers. Per Kitsap County code, “curbside compostable organics collection service will be available to all single-family and multifamily customers within the curbside collection boundaries”. These revisions will not result in either an increase or decrease to our current tariff rates to our residential and multi-family customers. We request that these changes go into effect on July 19, 2022.

Enclosed for your review is Chapter 9.48 of the Kitsap County Code which reflects the default cart sizes and multifamily organics program requirements. If you have any questions or need additional information, please contact me at (425) 814-7870.
