RE: Tariff Submittal – General Rate Case - Yakima Waste Systems, Inc. G-89.

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

Attached please find revised pages for Tariff Number 12, for Yakima Waste Systems, Inc. G-89.

With this filing, we respectfully request the Commission approve a general rate increase to recover new capital, higher costs of employee wages, benefits, fuel and general operating costs. The impact of providing more customers with carts, who currently have customer owned cans, and changing a portion of residential customers who have 1.5 yard containers to 96 gallon company provided carts, is also intended to be recovered with this filing.

The revenue requirement is proposed as follows: Residential service \$482,000, 5.8%; commercial service \$230,000, 5.8%; roll-off service \$153,000, 5.8%; residential recycling service \$164,000, 44.3%; and yard waste service (\$8,000), (9.4%). There are approximately 13,200 residential; 8,700 commercial; 430 roll-off; 3,200 residential recycling; and 670 yard waste customers affected by this change.

The last general rate increase approved by The Commission for Yakima Waste Systems, Inc. became effective May 1, 2021.

Attached are the proposed tariff pages containing the increased rates, as well as supporting documentation for those changes. If these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission they are intended to become effective on August 1, 2022.

Included in this filing is confidential information. To protect certain non-regulated proprietary information we are filing a portion of this filing as confidential, and are filing in accordance with WAC 480-07-160.

A rate increase notification letter will be mailed to all customers affected by these proposed changes no later than June 30, 2022. A notice letter will also be delivered on or before June 30, 2022 to the office of the Yakima County Council Chair.
