Fuel index prices have increased from \$2.7304 per gallon for the base period to \$5.2975 per gallon current price. Proposed changes are to add a Special Fuel Surcharge Supplement No. 1 in the amount of 0.24%.

1. The Commission finds good cause to support the request and authorize the proposed changes to become effective with Less Than Statutory Notice on: December 1, 2022.
2. The proposed changes will expire on: February 28, 2023.
3. The temporary 0.24% fuel surcharge in all rates and charges is the result of increased fuel costs incurred by the company during the months of August 2022, September 2022, and October 2022 to be collected from customers as follows:

For customers who are billed monthly for services in arrears, the fuel surcharge applies to all services provided in the months of December 2022, January 2023 and February 2023

Customers who are billed quarterly for services – current month and two months in advance:
