Dear Amanda Maxwell,

My name is Timothy Irwin, and I am the owner of Happiest Movers LLC. I am writing regarding my household goods permit #THG070329, which was cancelled on September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022. I understand that because the permit has been cancelled for more than 30 days, I cannot apply to reinstate per WAC 480-15-302(11). Therefore, I am requesting an exemption from WAC 480-15-302(11) to allow my pending application to reinstate permit #THG070329 in docket TV-220920 proceed prior to September 15, 2023, which will be 12 months after the date of cancellation. Below I will provide you with the reasons for losing the insurance and why it took more than 30 days to get the insurance reinstated.

I had to go to California to take care of a family emergency, and I had no employees to run operations while I was gone. Because the company was not operating during this time, I was no longer able to afford the required auto liability insurance. Since I was unable to pay the insurance premium, my insurance was cancelled, and subsequently my permit. Now I am back in Washington, and I have a steady income secondary employment during the slow season which has enabled Happiest Movers LLC to have enough working capital to make sure this never happens again.

When I began in the moving industry, this was a challenge that I didn't think would happen, but it did, and I have learned from the experience. Now I have a solid business plan and ask for the Commission's consideration in the matter.
