
Dear Ms. Maxwell:

Attached for filing you will find the above referenced tariff sheets. The purposes of this filing are (1) to change the bill due date from 20 days to 15 days after the issue date and (2) combine the Service Order and Line Connection charges into one charge call the Installation Charge. There is no change to the amount the customer pays.

The third change is to establish an NSF charge when a payment is not honored or is declined. The Company is charged a fee by the financial institution when this occurs. The customer causing the charge should be responsible for it. Based on 2022 activity, the charge may generate approximately \$350.00 in annual revenue.

This applies to the Mt. Hull Exchange.
