

Attached for filing you will find the above referenced tariff sheet. The purpose of this filing is to clarify the disconnection rules for an excessive heat warning, a heat advisory, an excessive heat watch, or similar alert made by the National Weather Service as required by Engrossed Substitute House Bill 1329. The rule change prevents residential customers disconnection during such an alert. The Commission sua sponte waived the thirty day notice and customer notice requirements in its Notice of June 30, 2023.
