NOTICE OF INTENT TO CANCEL

NOTICE OF BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE
PROCEEDING; SETTING TIME FOR
ORAL STATEMENTS

(Set for January 31, 2024, at 1:30 p.m.)

- 1 The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission), on its own motion, and through its regulatory staff (Staff), alleges as follows:
- 2 The Commission is an agency of the state of Washington authorized by statute to regulate the rates, services, facilities, and practices of public service companies, including household goods carriers.
- 3 Marsik Movers, LLC (Marsik Movers or the Company) is a Washington company engaging in business as a household goods carrier. The Company currently holds Commission-issued provisional permit number THG-068754 and US Department of Transportation number 3257682.
- 4 The Company began operations as a household goods carrier on May 23, 2019 under a provisional permit of authority.¹
- 5 In December 2023, Staff completed a follow-up investigation of the Company and documented, in an investigation report dated December 14, 2023, that the Company had committed one critical violation of regulations and 10 total violations, resulting in a proposed conditional safety rating.²
- 6 A carrier may request a change in its safety rating based on evidence that it has taken corrective actions to address the identified violations and that company operations currently meet the safety fitness standard specified in 49 CFR § 385.5 and § 385.7.

- 7 The Commission will grant permanent operating authority to a carrier that successfully completes its provisional period. Doing so requires the carrier to, among other things, receive a satisfactory safety rating in a review conducted by Staff. WAC 480-15-305(1)(c). If a carrier fails to receive a satisfactory safety rating within 18 months of obtaining its provisional permit, the Commission will cancel the carrier's provisional permit and dismiss the company's application for permanent authority unless the Commission finds good cause to extend the provisional period. WAC 480-15-305(3).
- 8 Under the circumstances presented in this case, the Commission determines that it will afford Marsik Movers the same opportunity as companies that have received a proposed unsatisfactory rating to provide evidence, in the form of an approved safety management plan, showing that it has taken corrective action to address the identified violations. Marsik Movers must come into compliance with applicable laws by obtaining a Commission approval of a safety management plan no later than February 12, 2024. If the Company fails to come into compliance by that date, the Commission will cancel its household goods carrier permit effective February 13, 2024. Thereafter, as an unregistered company, Marsik Movers would be prohibited from providing household goods carrier service in the state of Washington.
- 9 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that it intends to cancel the permit and authority of Marsik Movers to provide services as a household goods carrier effective February 13, 2024, for cause, following a hearing on the factual allegations set out above, unless Marsik Movers obtains Commission approval of a safety management plan prior to that date.**
- 10 Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission schedules a hearing on its own initiative and determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate to determine whether the Commission should cancel Marsik Movers household goods carrier permit.
- 11 **THE COMMISSION GIVES FURTHER NOTICE that it will hold a virtual brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 1:30 p.m. on January 31, 2024. - 12 The record in this case will consist of any documents regarding the matter that are considered by or prepared for the presiding officer for the brief adjudicative proceeding and a transcript of any oral statements given at the hearing, which statements will be given under oath.

- 13 Written notice of any other stage in the proceeding or other formal proceedings that the Commission may deem appropriate will be given during the course of this case. The Commission will provide at its offices in Lacey, Washington, copies of documents in the current record for use by the parties or others who may want to review them.
- 14 **Marsik Movers must submit its proposed safety management plan no later than 5:00 p.m. January 17, 2024.** Parties wishing to submit any other documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding must file with the Commission a list enumerating and describing any such documents **no later than 5:00 p.m. on January 24, 2024**, and email copies of those documents to the other parties and the presiding officer by 5:00 p.m. on January 24, 2024. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140.
- 15 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the brief adjudicative proceeding set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default under RCW 34.05.440 and WAC 480-07-450.**
