Re: Review Committee Decision – Complaint Case 24-004 NW Natural Gas vs. Tapias Landscaping, LLC.

Dear Mr. Killip:

The Washington State Dig Law Safety Committee (committee) received a complaint filed by NW Natural Gas against Tapias Landscaping, LLC (Tapias) regarding a potential violation of the Washington State Dig Law RCW 19.122.030.

On April 11, 2024, the committee formed a peer review board and reviewed Complaint Case 24-004.

The peer review board determined that the respondent, Tapias, violated RCW 19.122.030(2) one time for failure to provide notice to a one-number locator service not less than two business days before the scheduled excavation date.

Therefore, the committee recommends a total penalty of \$1,000 be assessed to the respondent as follows:

 \$1,000 for one violation of RCW 19.122.030(2) that occurred on Feb. 20, 2024, at 8011 NE 171st Ave, Vancouver, WA

Additionally, the committee recommends a deferral opportunity be offered to suspend \$800 of the \$1,000 total, based on the conditions that Tapias' owners and lead employees take NUCA Dig Safe Training, and incur no additional violations of RCW 19.122 within the next 12 months.
