Enclosed are proposed revisions to Tariff 9.1 of Rubatino Refuse Removal, LLC (G-58).

This filing increases residential yard waste rates due to the upcoming increase at Cedar Grove Composting. This filing also adds July 4^{th} as a regular holiday. The holiday was added as a one-time supplement in 2024 and is now expected to be permanent.

If approved, this change will increase revenue by approximately \$31,600 or about .10~% on company revenue

We request LSN treatment with tariff revisions to go into effect April 1, 2025. We further request LSN treatment with regards to customer notice. Customers will be notified on their next regular billing.
