RE: Tariff Submittal – B&O Increase - Harold LeMay Enterprises, Inc., dba City Sanitary, Joe's Refuse, White Pass Garbage G-98, Revised Tariff No. 11,

Dear Mr. Killip:

Attached please find revised pages for Tariff Number 11, for Harold LeMay Enterprises, Inc., dba City Sanitary, Joe's Refuse, White Pass Garbage G-98.

Our Company was notified that effective October 1, 2025 the B&O tax is set to increase from 1.75% to 2.10%. With this filing, we respectfully request the Commission approve a rate increase to pass this increase through to customers.

The increase for Lewis County is proposed as follows: Residential service \$12,500, 0.39%; commercial service \$11,000, 0.39%; roll-off service \$2,700, 0.39%; residential/multi-family recycling service \$5,150, 0.37%; and yard waste service \$260, 0.37%. There are approximately 12,900 residential; 2,100 commercial; 90 roll-off; 11,250 residential recycling; 7 multi-family recycling; and 400 yard waste customers affected by this change.

For customers receiving service in Thurston County below 142nd Ave the proposed change is as follows: Residential service \$4,500, 0.38%; commercial service \$3,200, 0.38%; roll-off service \$1,400, 0.38%; residential/multifamily recycling service \$2,500, 0.37%; and yard waste service \$78, 0.37%. There are approximately 4,600 residential; 600 commercial; 30 roll-off; 4,600 residential recycling; 290 multi-family recycling; and 100 yard waste customers affected by this change.

The last general rate increase approved by The Commission for City Sanitary, Joe's Refuse, White Pass Garbage became effective May 1, 2024.

Attached are the proposed tariff pages containing the increased rates, as well as supporting documentation for those changes. If these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission they are intended to become effective on October 1, 2025.

We respectfully ask that this filing be accepted under LSN, per WAC 480-70-276 for customer notification. If the LSN is accepted and these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, the rates will become effective on October 1, 2025. Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2)(a)(iii), affected customers will receive notification of this change on the billing reflecting the revised rates.
