On June 20, 1994, Stroh's Water Company, Inc., (Stroh's) filed with the Commission revisions to its currently effective tariff WN U-1 in Docket UW-940833. Stroh's currently serves approximately 600 customers near the southwest side of Gig Harbor.

The revisions are designated as:

- 3rd Revision Sheet No. 2, Index and
- Canceling Original sheet No. 21b, Dr. Kuntz Service Area.

The Commission, on July 21, 1994, entered a Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revision pending an investigation concerning the charges and reasonableness and justness thereof.

This tariff revision is a filing to bring water system's rates to parity for the former Dr. Kuntz's system (25 customers) and to include the cost of the water system in rate base. The revenue impact of this filing will be an additional \$1,263 per year.

The company states the advantages to all customers in adding this system is:

1. It will add two (2) additional wells to the system and this is a very large advantage since new water rights are very difficult to obtain.
2. This system is located at the most distant point of the Stroh's water system and will give added capacity and reliability.
3. It will give Stroh's a greater revenue base and so delay the need for any rate increase.

FINDINGS

1. Stroh's Water Company, Inc., is a water utility company and as such is a public service company subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
2. The revision presently under suspension herein are not considered to be unreasonable.
3. It is not contrary to public interest that the Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revision in this docket be dismissed and that the revision to the respondent's Tariff WN U-1 become effective February 1, 1995.

O R D E R

THE COMMISSION THEREFORE ORDERS That the Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revision in this docket, UW-940833, dated July 21 1994, be and the same is hereby dismissed, and that the filing herein filed June 20, 1994, be and the same shall become effective February 1, 1995.
