Ready to Serve Water Service

Summit View Water Works, LLC has asked the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC) to approve an application to increase ready to serve (RTS) water service rates. If approved, the new rates will become effective November 1, 2022. This increase would generate an estimated additional \$648.00 in annual revenue from all RTS water customers served. This estimate is based on the current number of homes under construction at this time. This is a 17% increase over current rates.

Our water company has not had a rate case review since 2018. Since that time, we have continued to see an increase in costs. Over the intervening period, we have absorbed the increased costs.

The increased RTS rate would now be the same rate as our domestic customer's base rate. We will continue to charge a flat rate during construction.

The additional revenue generated is to cover increased costs, such as power, supplies, and labor.
