## AMENDMENT 6 TO SUPPLEMENTAL WORK ORDER 04-01 TO CONTRACT NUMBER T02-TSD-319 FOR ADVANCED TRANSPORT SERVICES

- 4. Miscellaneous. This Sixth Amendment will be effective as of the date it is executed by Qwest after the Customer's execution (the "Sixth Amendment Effective Date") and be deemed incorporated by reference into the Agreement. All other terms and conditions in the Agreement will remain in full force and effect and be binding upon the parties. This Sixth Amendment and the Agreement set forth the entire understanding between the parties as to the subject matter herein, and in the event there are any inconsistencies between the documents, the terms of the Agreement will control.
