Mr. Jungers, Mr. Cain, Mr. Simmons and representatives of the District shall in good faith endeavor to identify and engage in a constructive dialogue to resolve issues with respect to Rate Schedule 100, including but not limited to eliminating differences in the dollar amount of the monthly standard services charge for commercial and residential subscribers

C. Reservation of Commission Authority.

4. It is acknowledged that the District is a municipal corporation governed by a duly elected five member Board of Commissioners (Commission). Pursuant to RCW
