## TO ALL PARTIES:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered its Order 01, Order Granting Telrite Corporation d/b/a Life Wireless (Telrite or the Company) Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier in Docket UT-110321 on June 13, 2013.

The Order requires the Company to meet 21 conditions to be classified as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier, and directs the Company to submit compliance filings with regard to several of the conditions. Among others, Condition #2 requires the Company to submit data for Commission approval before it can begin offering service in the state of Washington. Condition #10 requires the Company to work with the Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) to establish a procedure to verify the Company's Lifeline customers' eligibility.

On July 1, 2013, Telrite submitted a compliance filing pursuant to Washington State Condition #2 of Commission Order 01 (Appendix A) in this docket, for approval by the Commission. The Company's compliance filing contains a copy of Telrite's Lifeline rate plans, terms and conditions, proposed language to be used in marketing and advertising material, and its Lifeline Customer Enrollment Form. After Commission Staff reviewed the compliance filing and discussed it with the Company's representative, Telrite submitted revisions to the compliance filing on August 5, 2013, and August 8, 2013. Staff finds that the Company's final revised compliance filing is satisfactory and meets the requirements of Condition #2 set forth in the Commission's Order 01.

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Telrite also informed Commission Staff that it has contacted the Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) to obtain access to the DSHS database to verify its Lifeline customers' eligibility. This complies with Condition #10 of Commission Order 01.

On August 12, 2013, Commission Staff submitted a letter recommending that the Commission approve the compliance filing.

The Commission has examined Telrite's compliance filing and subsequent revisions and finds that the Company's compliance filing meets Condition #2 and Condition #10 of Commission Order 01. The Commission approves Telrite's revised compliance filing.
