Dear Mr. Johnson:

On May 31, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) issued a Notice of Intent to Cancel the Household Goods Carrier Permit of We Like to Move It, Move It!! LLC (We Like to Move It or company) for failure to attend required commission-sponsored household goods training.

On June 5, 2019, commission staff (staff) filed a letter to the docket stating that the company intended to attend the August 7, 2019, household goods training and that the brief adjudicative proceeding scheduled for June 11, 2019, be suspended.

On June 7, 2019, the commission issued a notice suspending the procedural schedule and instructed staff to file a status report concerning the company's attendance at the August 7, 2019, commission-sponsored household goods carrier training.

Staff has verified that We Like to Move It owner, Joshua Manion, attended the entire household goods training on August 7, 2019. The company has satisfied this mandatory training requirement.

Staff recommends that the procedural schedule in this matter be canceled.
