Dear Mr. Johnson:

The Washington Military Department (WMD), State E9-1-1 Coordination Office (SECO), is requesting status as an interested party, or possibly in a limited intervention, in the subject PS/ALI Complaint. In accordance with Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 38.52.520, the SECO is responsible for coordinating and facilitating the implementation and operation of enhanced 911 emergency communications systems throughout the state. While the SECO is not statutorily responsible for gathering or entering the commercial PS/ALI data into the State's ALI database, the State's Emergency Services IP network (ESInet) uses the information to get commercial phone location information to first responders quickly. As such, SECO and the counties, will be impacted by the ruling in this proceeding. The SECO is ready and willing to participate in the proceeding and will be filing a statement with the UTC if permitted.
