Note 6: For customers on automated service routes: The company will assess roll-out charges where, due to circumstances outside the control of the driver, the driver is required to move an automated cart or toter more than 5 feet but less than 25 feet in order to reach the truck. The charge for this roll-out service is: \$0.63 per cart or toter, per pickup. If a cart or toter must be moved over 25 feet then the charge will be \$0.63 for the first 25 feet plus \$0.12 per increment of 5 feet.

- (4) Would negatively impact or otherwise damage road surface integrity.
