## **Response:**

Staff has attached census figures for Walla Walla County, Columbia County, and the cities of Walla Walla, College Place and Dayton as Attachment A to its response to this data request. That data shows population growth in those counties and cities. Staff assumes that population growth is likely associated with increased levels of demand for power and therefore generally expanded markets for electric service providers. Staff concludes from this data that CREA has expanded its operations into Pacific Power's service territory to take advantage of this growing market for electrical service.
