Good afternoon,

An evidentiary hearing in these dockets is scheduled to begin at 1 p.m. on Thursday, February 6, 2020, and will continue, as necessary, at 9 a.m. on Friday, February 7. Please note that this email contains unique instructions related to witness panels, which appear below in red.

The Commission requires parties to electronically file and serve their proposed cross-examination exhibits by Friday, January 31, 2020, at 5 p.m. Hard copies must be furnished simultaneously.

We will expect to receive at the Commission by 5 p.m. on January 31, 2020:

1. An electronic file from each party that lists each of your proposed cross-examination exhibits by witness or witness panel (see below for further explanation regarding witness panels). Please use the template exhibit list file that is attached to this e-mail to compile your list. **Please mark and identify each exhibit for the exhibit list with the initials of the witness for whom the exhibit is identified, but do not mark your cross-examination exhibits with exhibit numbers.** We will assign numbers when compiling the final list for hearing.
2. Six sets (an original and five paper copies) of your proposed cross-examination exhibits for each witness (individual exhibits must be separated by an index sheet with a blank tab on the right side; every sheet and index tab must be three-hole punched (oversize holes preferred); every page of every exhibit

must have a page number).

You will also need to provide two sets of your proposed cross-examination exhibits to the party sponsoring each witness you intend to cross-examine (*i.e.*, one for counsel, one for the witness), and one set of your proposed cross-examination exhibits to each party not sponsoring the witness. Parties, by prior arrangement among themselves, may waive receipt of an additional copy of any document provided during discovery.

I have attached a blank exhibit list to use as a template for your exhibit list. You must e-mail your exhibit list to all other parties at the same time you provide it to the Commission.

We will mark all of the proposed cross-examination exhibits with numbers, update the exhibit list, and send you a copy via e-mail by COB on Monday, February 3. The parties should review the exhibit list for any errors and submit any proposed changes to the presiding ALJ.

Due to the large number of PSE witnesses who filed testimony addressing attrition, cost of capital, and cost of service/rate spread/rate design, we will assemble PSE witness panels for those issues, as follows:

1. **Attrition panel:** Amen, Doyle, Mills, Rabago, Kensok, Piliaris, Free, Marcelia, and Koch
2. **Cost of capital panel:** Doyle, McArthur, Morin
3. **Cost of service, rate spread, and rate design panel:** Piliaris, Jhaveri, Taylor, Chang, and Amen

Parties who wish to cross-examine any of the panel witnesses may ask questions of specific witnesses or may ask questions of the panel generally. Parties are also free, of course, to cross-examine the panel witnesses individually on any other topic once all panels have adjourned.

The parties should coordinate among themselves to provide the Commission with their proposed order of witnesses and witness panels, with the caveat that the witness panels should convene before any of PSE's individual witnesses are called. The parties should also provide estimates of the time each party requires for cross-examination of each witness or witness panel using the table that is attached to this email.

Please designate one party to furnish the agreed order of presentation and cross-examination estimates via email to the presiding ALJ no later than the close of business on January 31.

Parties' representatives who wish to conduct cross-examination must appear at the hearing in person. Similarly, all witnesses for whom cross-examination is proposed must also appear at the hearing in person. If no party proposes to cross-examine a witness, the witness need not appear at the hearing, but must be made available by telephone if requested by the presiding ALJ.

If you have questions, these should be posed by e-mail to the presiding ALJ. Please include all of the parties in the CC address line so that everyone stays fully informed.
