Since the Amended Complaint in this proceeding was served on August 15, 2004, the Commission has dismissed all allegations against or approved settlement agreements with a number of the respondents named in the Amended Complaint. Those parties with approved settlement agreements, or against whom all allegations have been dismissed, include Allegiance, ATG, Covad, Electric Lightwave, Fairpoint, Global Crossing, Integra, MCI, and XO. Eschelon and Staff filed a settlement agreement with the Commission on August 12, 2004.
