On March 14, 2001 the Commission directed the Staff to prepare a Rule Adoption Order in matters specific to the above-cited dockets. Avista has initiated the internal process of changing computer code, billing systems and procedures to be in compliance with the pending rules. It appears that the new rules will be adopted and effective prior to the conclusion of the Company completing its computer reprogramming. The Company estimates that this change-over process will take approximately four months. The Company is making a "best effort" to comply with the new rules.

No action is requested at this time. However, Avista wishes to reiterate its comments made at the March 14 meeting that the Company may, upon codification of the new rules, request a temporary waiver of several rules.
