"Use" means "Use" -- a utility must use the electricity to serve the load of that utility.

"REC" -- in accordance with both Washington State's and the EPA's definition of a "REC" no portion of a "REC" may even possibly come from electricity generated to meet a federal, state, or local government mandate. A "REC" only exists "in addition" to any such mandate. Any state or jurisdiction which allows "RECs" to be issued (and not immediately retired) for such a government mandate *IS* engaging in "double-counting" and no use of any purported "RECs" originating from such a fraudulent state or local jurisdiction should be permitted.
