*Synopsis:* The Commission approves and adopts the settlement agreement, grants the requested waivers, and dismisses the complaint with prejudice.

- Proceeding: Docket No. UT-040018 is a complaint and alleging that AT&T refuses to pay the complainant's tariffed rates for carrier access services.
- Appearances. Richard A. Finnigan, attorney, Olympia, Washington, represents complainant Computer 5\*, Inc. d/b/a LocalTel Communications (LocalTel). Letty S. D. Friesen, attorney, Denver, Colorado, represents AT&T Communications of the Pacific Northwest, Inc. (AT&T).
- Settlement. On May 21, 2004, the parties filed a settlement agreement and motion to dismiss all claims with prejudice. The settlement agreement provides that:

- AT&T will pay LocalTel \$450.48 in resolution of charges for all switched access services provided by LocalTel through January 31, 2004.<sup>1</sup>
- For the period February 1, 2004 through December 31, 2005, pursuant to the terms of the settlement agreement and AT&T's CLEC Letter of Agreement (LOA),<sup>2</sup> the rates for intrastate access will be governed by the Washington Exchange Carriers Association (WECA) tariff on file with the Commission.<sup>3</sup>
- For the period February 1, 2004 through December 31, 2005, the rate for interstate access will be governed by the LOA.
- LocalTel's complaint against AT&T should be dismissed with prejudice.

A copy of the settlement agreement is attached to this Order as Appendix A and incorporated by reference herein.

Discussion and decision. The Commission is persuaded that adopting the proposed settlement agreement and granting the requested waivers and motion to dismiss will serve the public interest. Resolution of this complaint will assist both carriers to continue to do business in Washington on the basis of a fuller and more accurate understanding of the charges for access services provided by LocalTel.

## **ORDER**

THE COMMISSION ORDERS That the proposed settlement agreement, attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein is approved and adopted, that the

requested waivers of WAC 480-07-735 and WAC 480-07-740 are granted, and that LocalTel's complaint is dismissed with prejudice.
