(Implements RCW 34.05.310) Do **NOT** use for expedited rule making

Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission

Subject of possible rule making: The subject of this inquiry is to consider whether the Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) should develop a new rule and/or modify existing rules in WAC 480-90 (Gas Companies) and WAC 480-100 (Electric Companies) to

settlement stipulations. This inquiry supplements the original CR-101 filed at
