AGREED REQUEST FOR  
EXTENSION OF TIME

1 The Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission request that the Commission extend the time for filing Staff response testimony and exhibits from July 15, 2011, to July 22, 2011, and the time for filing the rebuttal testimony and exhibits of Summit View Water Works from August 8, 2011, to August 15, 2011. No change in the current hearing date of August 26, 2011, is requested. The Company has authorized Staff to represent the Company's agreement with this request.

2 The standard applicable to Staff's request is contained in WAC 480-07-385(2):

The commission will grant a continuance if the requesting party demonstrates good cause for the continuance and the continuance will not prejudice any party or the commission. The commission will grant a timely request to which all parties expressly agree unless it is inconsistent with the public interest or the commission's administrative needs.


3 Over the last two weeks, Staff and the Company have been engaged in settlement discussions and would prefer to continue those discussions without the press of the current litigation schedule. Good cause, therefore, exists for the Commission to grant the requested extension of time.

4           Moreover, because no change in the scheduled hearing date is requested, an extension of time to file the parties' remaining testimony and exhibits will not prejudice the Commission. Nor will the requested extension of time be inconsistent with the public interest or the Commission's administrative needs.

5           For these reasons, the Agreed Request for Extension of Time should be granted by the Commission.


