On November 1, 2021, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light (Pacific Power or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a Petition for Exemption from Washington Administrative Code 480-100-605 (Petition), which requires that the alternative lowest cost and reasonably available portfolio include the social cost of greenhouse gases in the resource acquisition decision.
