Commission Staff's Recommendation to Waive Suspended Penalties Dockets TE-220497

Dear Jeff Killip:

On October 13, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a notice canceling Brief Adjudicative Proceeding and Requiring Filing of Settlement Agreement for Docket TE-220497.

November 4, 2022, the Commission entered Order 02, Approving Settlement Agreement in Docket TE-220497. Order 02 assessed Jumpin' Joey's LLC d/b/a Lymelight Party Bus (Jumpin' Joey's or Company) a penalty of \$10,000, and suspended a \$8,500 portion of the penalty for a period of two years, and then waived, subject to the Company cease and desist its operations as a charter party or excursion service carrier within the state of Washington without first obtaining the required certificate.

On December 8, 2022, the Company paid the non-suspended portion penalty of \$1,500 in full. Commission staff find that Jumpin' Joey's satisfied the conditions of Order 02 and recommend that the \$8,500 suspended penalty be waived.
