## **MOTION**

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission Staff (Staff) moves to dismiss allegations against McLeodUSA Telecommunications, Inc. (McLeodUSA) and Qwest Corporation (Qwest) relating to agreements 41A (Ex. TLW-35), 42A (Ex. TLW-36), and 46A (Ex. TLW-39) listed on Exhibit A to the Amended Complaint.

Staff has investigated the allegations relating to these agreements and has discovered that these agreements are not Interconnection Agreements under Section 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (47 U.S.C. § 151 *et seq.*) ("the Act"). Agreements 41A, 42A, and 46A are not an interconnection agreements because they do not create an ongoing obligation related to the provision of local interconnection service.
