Please identify all FERC accounts that PSE will use to record the transactions associated with net plant and future receivables for Schedule 75, and explain what each FERC account will be used for.

Response:

Puget Sound Energy ("PSE") anticipates using gas FERC account 386 "Other property on customers' premises" for natural gas assets offered under Schedule 75. FERC account 386 is the same FERC account currently being used for the existing rental service program.

To differentiate between natural gas assets in the existing rental service and assets deployed under the new Lease Solutions service, different subaccounts will be assigned under gas FERC account 386. Additionally, PSE anticipates using electric FERC account 372 "Leased property on Customers' premises" for electric assets offered under Schedule 75. Each of these subsidiary-level FERC accounts roll up to FERC 101 "Plant in service". Accounts receivable from Schedule 75 customers will be recognized in FERC account "Customer accounts receivable".
