Please describe which level of public participation from the IAP2 Public Participation Spectrum applies to PSE's engagement with each of its advisory groups in development of the CEIP.

Response:

For development of Puget Sound Energy's ("PSE's") 2021 Clean Energy Implementation Plan ("CEIP"), engagement with the Equity Advisory Group ("EAG") primarily occurred at the "involve" and "collaborate" levels. For a given agenda, engagement may range some of or the entire spectrum. For example, at the upcoming Sept. 19, 2022 EAG meeting, members will be discussing an equity discussion guide at the "collaborate" level and then providing feedback on a potential approach to analyzing customer benefits at the "involve" level.

PSE's other advisory groups engaged primarily in the "consult" and "involve" range. Engagement with the Conservation Resources Advisory Group ("CRAG") and Low-Income Advisory Committee ("LIAC") in developing the CEIP was mostly at the "inform" level. Engagement with the Integrated Resource Plan stakeholder group was mostly at the "consult" level depending on the topic. Appendix C-3 and C-6 of the CEIP includes all of the meeting materials and engagement with each advisory group.
