TO ALL PARTIES:

On October 24, 2025, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Order 03 Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hybrid Evidentiary Hearing in the above-identified docket (Order 03).<sup>1</sup> The Commission is initiating a new process, which introduces a technical workshop into the procedural schedule for energy rate case proceedings, as discussed during the prehearing conference held on October 10, 2025.

The technical workshop is intended to review the structure and functionality of the utility's revenue requirement model and subsequently how that model interacts with the cost-of-service exhibit(s). All parties to the proceeding are welcome to attend but must have executed a Confidential Non-disclosure Agreement for their participants, as required by Order 02 Protective Order in this docket, as confidential information may be displayed during the course of the workshop.

Further, this workshop is for demonstration purposes only and will not be recorded. The utility and all participants may not engage in substantive discussion regarding the merits of any revenue adjustment as Commission Policy Accounting Advisors and the assigned Administrative Law Judge are also participating in the workshop.<sup>2</sup>
