Dear Judge Kopta:

The relevant members of Commission Staff (Staff) have reviewed Cascade Natural Gas Corporation's (Cascade or Company) June 13, 2017, petition to exceed WEAF annual budgets and defer program costs as necessary. The Company's account of the circumstances and advisory board negotiations described in the filing is accurate. Staff participated in negotiations and supports Cascade's petition as filed. Staff thus recommends the Commission issue an order authorizing Cascade to:

- 1. exceed the "not-to-exceed" WEAF program budgets for the 2016 through 2021 program years, as established in Order 04 of Docket UG-152286;
- 2. seek the annual collection of WEAF program funding that is 15% over the 'not to exceed amounts' after consideration with the WEAF Advisory Committee;
- 3. establish a 5% soft cap to the program year budgets; and
- 4. defer program costs that exceed those collected through Schedule 593, Washington Energy Assistance Fund (WEAF) Program Cost Recovery.
