**NOTICE MODIFYING START TIME OF EVIDENTIARY HEARING  
(Now set for February 6, 2020, at 1 p.m., and continuing as needed  
on February 7, 2020, at 9 a.m.)**

TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 20, 2019, Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective tariff WN U-60, Tariff G, Electric Service, and WN U-2 Tariff, Natural Gas Service.

On July 22, 2019, the Commission entered Order 03, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing (Order 03), which established a procedural schedule that included, among other things, an evidentiary hearing set for February 6-7, 2020, at 9 a.m.

On February 5, 2020, it came to the Commission's attention it had not formally communicated to the parties that, due to scheduling conflicts, the start time for the evidentiary hearing will be postponed until later in the afternoon.

Due to scheduling conflicts, including the Commission's regularly scheduled open meeting, the Commission finds good cause to reschedule the evidentiary hearing to begin at 1 p.m. on February 6, 2020. The hearing will continue as needed on February 7, 2020, at 9 a.m.

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the evidentiary hearing in Dockets UE-190529, UG-190530, UE-190274, UG-190275, UE-190991, UG-190992, UE-171225, and UG-171226 is rescheduled to Thursday, February 6, 2020, beginning at 1 p.m., in the Commission's Richard Hemstad Hearing Room, 621 Woodland Square Loop SE,**

**Lacey, Washington. The hearing will continue, as needed, on February 7, 2020,  
beginning at 9 a.m.**
