While we are unable at this time to further pursue our opposition to the application filed by Pacific Cruises Northwest, Inc., we urge the Commission to carefully evaluate on its own volition the merits of this application. We question whether the applicant is fit to provide the service applied-for in light of potential affiliated interest issues, some of which were raised by our discovery request, and in light of lack of operations under its existing authority. We also question whether the public interest justifies granting new authority where there are other existing certificates in the territory, some of which overlap the authority applied for and are owned by an entity with whom we believe the applicant has business relations.
