TO INTERESTED PERSONS:

This letter is to inform you of the status of the Commission's rulemaking to increase the maximum average annual revenue per customer jurisdictional threshold for water companies in WAC 480-110-255 and WAC 480-110-205, and clarify the accounting methodology in computing the revenue threshold in WAC 480-110-255. This letter also provides notice of an opportunity to file written comments on the proposed rules and to participate in the formal rule adoption hearing.

On January 31, 2005, the Commission filed a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (CR-102) in this docket with the Code Reviser. This action begins the final part of the rulemaking process, which includes a written comment period, a public adoption hearing, and a decision by the Commission.
