



Plan, appended to Qwest's SGAT. Copies of updated Exhibit K are attached.<sup>1</sup> This submission is being made to implement the change to section 7.5 of the QPAP which the Commission proposed in Order No. 2 in Docket UT-043007. Qwest, having canvassed the parties to Docket UT-043007, can represent that no party objects to the proposed modification to section 7.5 of the QPAP, and Qwest respectfully requests that the Commission issue its order permitting this change to become effective in such time that Qwest may transfer all funds that are currently in the Tier 2 escrow account for Washington into the Public Service Revolving Fund (PSRF) by the due date of Order No. 2. Qwest requires approximately two days lead time after receiving an order to issue the necessary funds transfer documents. In the alternative, if it is not possible for the Commission to issue its order permitting these changes to section 7.5 to the QPAP to become effective in time for Qwest to have two days between the date of the changes and the current May 7, 2004 due date for the transfer of \$625,000 from the escrow account to the PSRF, Qwest respectfully requests that the due date for the funds transfer be extended for the number of days necessary in order that Qwest may transfer all of the funds at one time.

#### DETAILED DESCRIPTIONS OF MODIFICATIONS

1. Qwest has modified Exhibit K by simply inserting the replacement language as proposed by the Commission in Order No. 2 at para. 16. This modification eliminates the escrow account and provides that Qwest will deposit any payments of Tier 2 funds for Washington into the PSRF now and henceforth. Qwest agrees with the substance of the Commission's proposed disposition of this issue, and simply requests that the Commission

immediately permit this change to become effective so that Qwest may be relieved of the burden of administering the escrow.

#### REQUESTED RELIEF

Qwest concurs with the Commission's findings at para. 15 of Order No. 2 in Docket UT-043007 that the change proposed to section 7.5 is fundamental and highly exigent. Qwest respectfully requests that the Commission permit the amended Exhibit K to go into effect no later than May 5, 2004 in accordance with 47 U.S.C. § 252(f)(3). Attached are a red-lined Exhibit K and a clean Exhibit K for the convenience of the Commission.

Qwest submits this notice in the three dockets captioned above. By submission in QPAP Docket UT-003022 and in SGAT Docket UT-003040 pursuant to section 16 of Exhibit K, the changes shall automatically apply to and modify all existing interconnection agreements that currently contain Exhibit K, the QPAP, as an exhibit.
