On March 24, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01 Granting Amended Accounting Petition (Order 01) in dockets UE-160203 and UG-160204. Order 01, among other things, required Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) to file updates every three months related to the Fee-Free Credit and Debit Card Payment Program's progress.

PSE filed its first updates on November 23, 2016, and quarterly thereafter through February 23, 2018.

On November 15, 2017, January 18, 2018, and March 9, 2018, Commission staff (Staff) filed letters informing the Commission that Staff had reviewed the most recently filed updates and determined that the updates complied with the requirements of Order 01.
