## NOTICE SUSPENDING PAYMENT PLAN (Next Installment Payment due by 5 p.m. on October 20, 2020)

RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment against Tiraogo Simpore, d/b/a TS Moving Services, in the amount of \$5,000, Dockets TV-190298 and TV-190299 (Consolidated)

## TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 4, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment (Penalty Assessment) against Tiraogo Simpore, d/b/a TS Moving Services, (TS Moving or Company) in the amount of \$5,000 for violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15. On June 20, 2019, the Commission entered Order 01, Order of Consolidation; Order Extending Provisional Permit; Order Imposing and Suspending Penalties, which imposed a reduced penalty of \$3,800, a \$2,500 portion of which was suspended subject to conditions. On July 8, 2019, the Commission entered Order 02, Granting Payment Arrangement (Order 02). Among other provisions, Order 02 approved a payment plan that permitted TS Moving to pay the \$1,300 portion of the penalty that was not suspended in 12 monthly installments, the first of which was due on July 22, 2019. To date, TS Moving has made nine timely payments and is in good standing.

Due to the economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Commission exercises its discretion to suspend the Company's payment plan for a period of six months. Accordingly, the remaining installments are due as follows:
