PACIFIC POWER DATA REQUEST NO. 16 TO CREA:

Does Columbia REA have access to grants, tax-free bonds, or low-interest loans from Federal or non-profit organizations, to further its business interests?

ERRATA RESPONSE TO PACIFIC POWER DATA REQUEST NO. 16:

CREA objects to Pacific Power Data Request No. 16 on the basis that the information requested is not relevant to the “primary issue in this proceeding [which] relates to the rates, terms, and conditions of [Pacific Power’s] proposed tariff filings,”^{1/} and is not reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence. Without waiving the foregoing objections, CREA responds as follows:

Yes. CREA does receive loans from the National Rural Utilities Cooperative Finance Corporation (“CFC”), a non-profit organization. However, it does not receive low-interest loans or grants from CFC, nor does it have access to tax-free bonds.
