**NOTICE REGARDING SUBMISSION OF  
CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION**

RE: *Judd and Herivel v. AT&T Communications of the Pacific Northwest, Inc. and  
T-Netix, Inc.*, Docket UT-042022

TO ALL PARTIES:

In reviewing the various Motions to Compel and Motion for a Protective Order (collectively with the Motions to Compel, "Motions") as well as the Oppositions to those Motions, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) has observed that some of the confidential information is being filed incorrectly by the Parties. Therefore, it is important that all of the Parties review the Commission's regulations addressing confidential information, WAC 480-07-160, specifically subsection 3- ***How to designate and seek protection of confidential information under this section***, and the information contained within the Protective Order, Order 02, issued March 18, 2005.

The Commission will accept the Motions and Oppositions to those Motions as a courtesy to the Parties this one time. In the future, when confidential information is submitted incorrectly, it will be rejected and returned to the sender pursuant to WAC 480-07-141.
