**NOTICE OF IMPENDING REVOCATION OF REGISTRATION  
AS A TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANY  
AND OPPORTUNITY TO REQUEST A HEARING**

Re: Revocation of Telecommunications Registration for Failure to File Annual Report and Pay Regulatory Fees; Docket No. UT-051260

TO TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANY:

Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission Staff) recently conducted its yearly review of annual reports and regulatory fees for telecommunications companies registered in the state of Washington. As a result, Commission Staff identified that Globcom Incorporated (Globcom) has not complied with regulatory requirements. Globcom failed to file its annual report for 2004 and failed to pay regulatory fees for 2005. This notice is being served on Globcom and its registered agents, if known, at their last known addresses on file with the Commission.

WAC 480-121-060 provides that the Commission may revoke a company's registration for good cause after notice and opportunity for a hearing. Good cause includes failure to file an annual report or pay regulatory fees. *WAC 480-121-060(1)(a) and (b)*. In addition, the Commission may impose a penalty not to exceed \$100 for each violation of statute, rule, or order under RCW 80.04.405. Each violation is a separate and distinct offense, and each day of a continuing violation will be deemed a separate and distinct violation. The Commission does not waive its authority to impose a penalty consistent with RCW 80.04.405 upon Globcom.

If Globcom wishes to avoid revocation of its registration, Globcom must, within 30 days of service of this notice, take one of two actions. The first option is to obtain regulatory compliance by submitting the delinquent annual report and paying the delinquent

regulatory fees. Annual report forms are available on the Commission's Internet web site – <http://www.wutc.wa.gov>. Annual report forms are also available by contacting the Commission by email at [annualreports@wutc.wa.gov](mailto:annualreports@wutc.wa.gov) or telephone at (360) 664-1160.

The second option is to request a hearing to demonstrate why Globcom's registration should not be revoked. All requests for hearing must comply with the Commission's procedural rules, chapter 480-07 WAC, which are available at the Commission's Internet web site – <http://www.wutc.wa.gov>.

Failure to respond within 30 days of this notice will result in the Commission entering an order revoking Globcom's registration without further notice. Unregistered companies are prohibited from providing telecommunications services in the state of Washington.
