RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. James Moseley, d/b/a You Got It Movers*
Commission Staff's Recommendation to Waive Suspended Penalties
Dockets TV-190808 and TV-190809 (*Consolidated*)

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

On November 20, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Consolidating Dockets; Approving Safety Management Plan; Extending Provisional Period; Imposing and Suspending Penalties in Dockets TV-190808 and TV-190809. Order 01 granted James Moseley, d/b/a You Got It Movers' (You Got It Movers or Company), request for mitigation, assessed a penalty of \$3,200, and suspended a \$2,000 portion of the reduced penalty for a period of two years, and then waived, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) You Got It Movers maintains a conditional safety rating;
- (2) Commission staff (Staff) conducts a follow-up investigation at least six months from the date of the order;
- (3) You Got It Movers must not incur any repeat critical violations upon re-inspection;
- (4) The Company's owner and assistant manager attend Commission-sponsored household goods training; and
- (5) You Got It Movers pays the \$1,200 penalty or works with Staff to establish a mutually agreeable payment arrangement.

On December 13, 2019, the Commission entered Order 02, Granting Payment Arrangement in consolidated Dockets TV-190808 and TV-190809. On October 26, 2020, the Company paid the penalty in full in accordance with the payment plan.

On December 18, 2019, the Company's owner and assistant manager attended Commission-sponsored household goods training.

On July 29, 2020, Staff completed the required follow-up safety investigation as outlined in Order 01. You Got It Movers did not receive any repeat violations of critical regulations and received a satisfactory safety rating.

Staff finds that You Got It Movers satisfied the conditions of Order 01 and recommends that the \$2,000 suspended penalty be waived.
