TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

On April 27, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity to File Written Comments (Notice). The Notice invited interested persons to respond to a composite workbook of utility filings and recommended actions by 5 p.m., Tuesday, May 25, 2021.

On May 25, 2021, Commission staff (Staff) notified the Commission that due to multiple deadlines it would be unable to meet the deadline to file written comments in this docket, and that it would file its comments by 5 p.m. on May 28, 2021. The Commission finds good cause to allow the late filing of comments by Staff, and therefore extends the deadline for all parties to file comments to Friday, May 28, 2021.
