**NOTICE SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

**and**

**NOTICE REQUIRING FILING OF SETTLEMENT DOCUMENTS**  
**(By May 30, 2024)**

RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Washington Water Supply, Inc.*,

TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 11, 2024, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) filed a complaint against Washington Water Supply, Inc. (Company) in Docket UW-230997. A virtual prehearing conference was held on March 25, 2024. Following the prehearing conference, the Commission issued an order setting the matter for an evidentiary hearing on August 26, 2024.

On April 25, 2024, counsel for Commission staff (Staff) contacted the presiding officer on behalf of the parties to inform the Commission that the parties (Settling Parties) have reached a settlement in principle and intend to file a settlement agreement and testimony in support thereof by May 30, 2024. The Settling Parties request that the Commission suspend the procedural schedule.

The Commission finds good cause to suspend the procedural schedule. The Settling Parties must file a settlement agreement and supporting documentation by May 30, 2024. If no settlement agreement is filed by May 30, 2024, Staff shall file direct testimony and exhibits by June 10, 2024, and the remaining dates, as outlined in Order 03 in this docket, shall remain in effect unless the parties petition the Commission for an alternative schedule.

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the procedural schedule in this matter is suspended.**

**THE COMMISSION GIVES FURTHER NOTICE That the Settling Parties must file a settlement agreement and supporting documentation no later than May 30, 2024.**
