12 13 14	On March 4, 1999, Puget Sound Energy, Inc. ("PSE") filed an Application for an Order under RCW						
15	5 Chapter 80.12 authorizing the proposed sale of PSE's ownership interest in the Colstrip Generating Units 1, 2, 3, and						
16	5 4 to PP&L Global, Inc., together with associated transmission assets (the "Colstrip Facilities"). The Application also						
17	seeks authorization for a five year amortization of any gain realized from the proposed sale.						
18	As set forth in the Application, PP&L Global intends to seek FERC approval to own and						
19	operate the Colstrip Facilities with exempt wholesale generator status. Because the Colstrip						
20	) Facilities are currently in PSE's rate base for its jurisdictional sales of electricity in this state, 15						
21	U.S.C. § 79z-5a(c) requires that PP&L Global include with its EWG application to FERC a						
22	2 statement that this Commission has determined that allowing the plant to be a wholesale facility						
23	operated by an EWG: "(1) will benefit consumers; (2) is in the public interest; and (3) does not						

24 violate State law."

This stipulation addresses only the EWG determination. This stipulation explicitly does not address any other issues, nor does it preclude the parties from raising, addressing or resolving any other issues, including, without limitation, the standard to be applied in resolving whether to approve the proposed sale or the appropriate regulatory treatment for any gain realized as a result of the sale. This stipulation has no effect with respect to approval of the proposed sale, the standard to be applied in resolving whether to approve the proposed sale or any issues other than the issue specifically addressed by the stipulation, i.e., the Commission making an EWG

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3	AGREEMENTS						
4	1. The parties agree that the Commission should grant the Company's request for						
5	EWG determination, conditioned upon the Commission's approval of the proposed sale of the						
6	Colstrip Facilities. A proposed order is attached to this stipulation.						
7	2. This parties agree that the EWG determination shall have no effect with respect to						
8	approval of the proposed sale, the standard to be applied in resolving whether to approve the						
9	proposed sale or any issues other than the EWG determination. If the Commission does not						
10	ultimately approve the proposed sale, the parties agree that the EWG determination shall be null						
11	and void.						
12	PROCEDURES						
13	1. The parties agree to support this Stipulation as a settlement of PSE's request for						
14	EWG determination. The parties understand that this Stipulation is not binding on the						
15	Commission.						
16	2. The parties wish to present this Stipulation to the Commission for its acceptance						
17	as soon as possible. A hearing is requested at which time each party will appear to present the						
18	Stipulation and answer questions the Commission may have with respect to the Stipulation.						
19	3. If the Commission rejects or modifies the Stipulation, each party reserves the						
20	right, upon written notice to the Commission and other parties within 2 business days, to						
21	withdraw from the Stipulation. If such right is exercised, the Company's request for EWG						
22	2 determination will be included in the procedural schedule established for the remainder of this						
23	proceeding, or such other schedule as may be deemed appropriate under the circumstances.						
24	4. The parties agree that this stipulation is not appropriate for resolving issues in any						
25	other proceeding.
